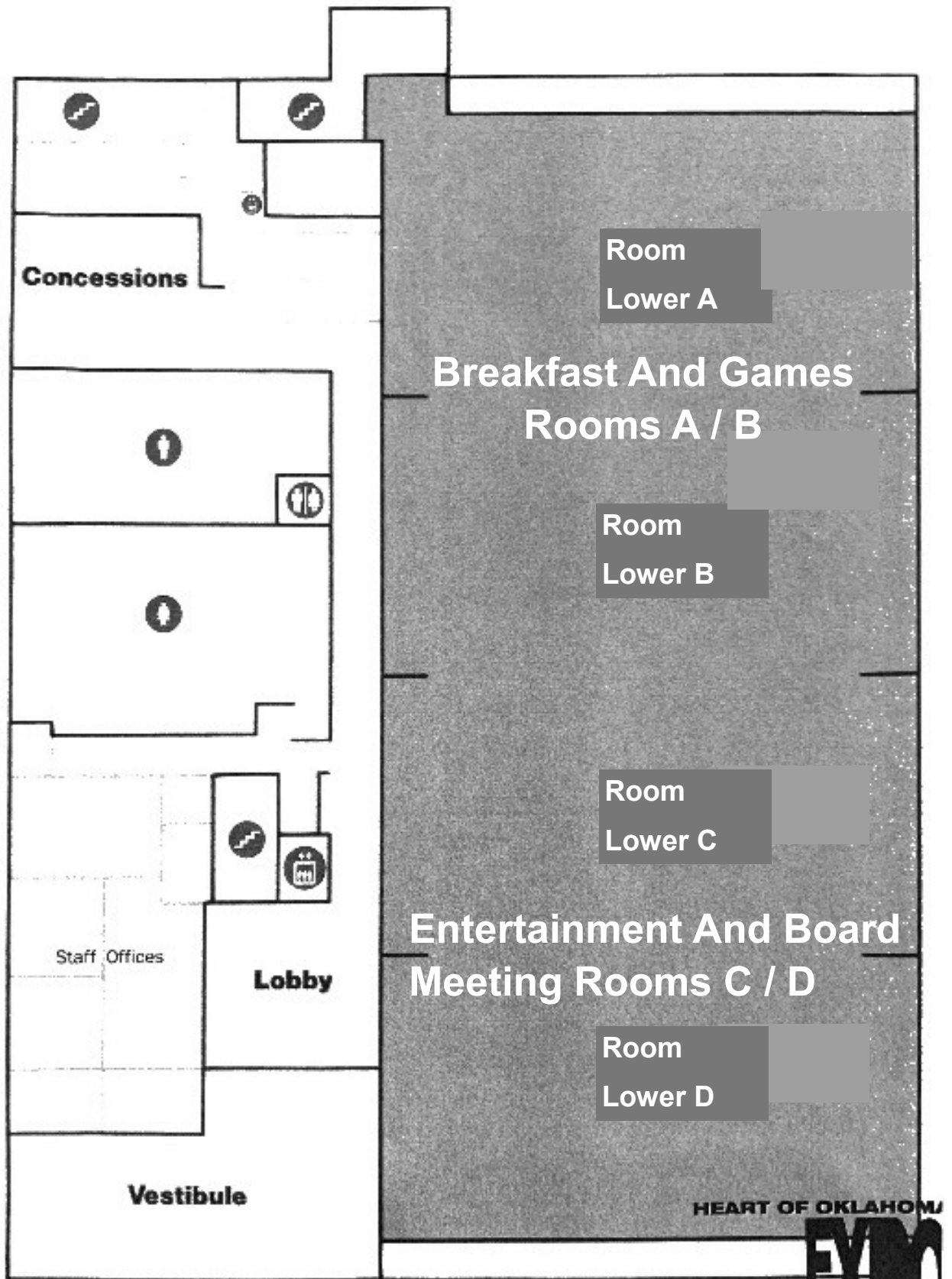


Dimension of board and locations for holes:
Board is 24 inches wide by 36 inches long. Holes are 4 inches in diameter.





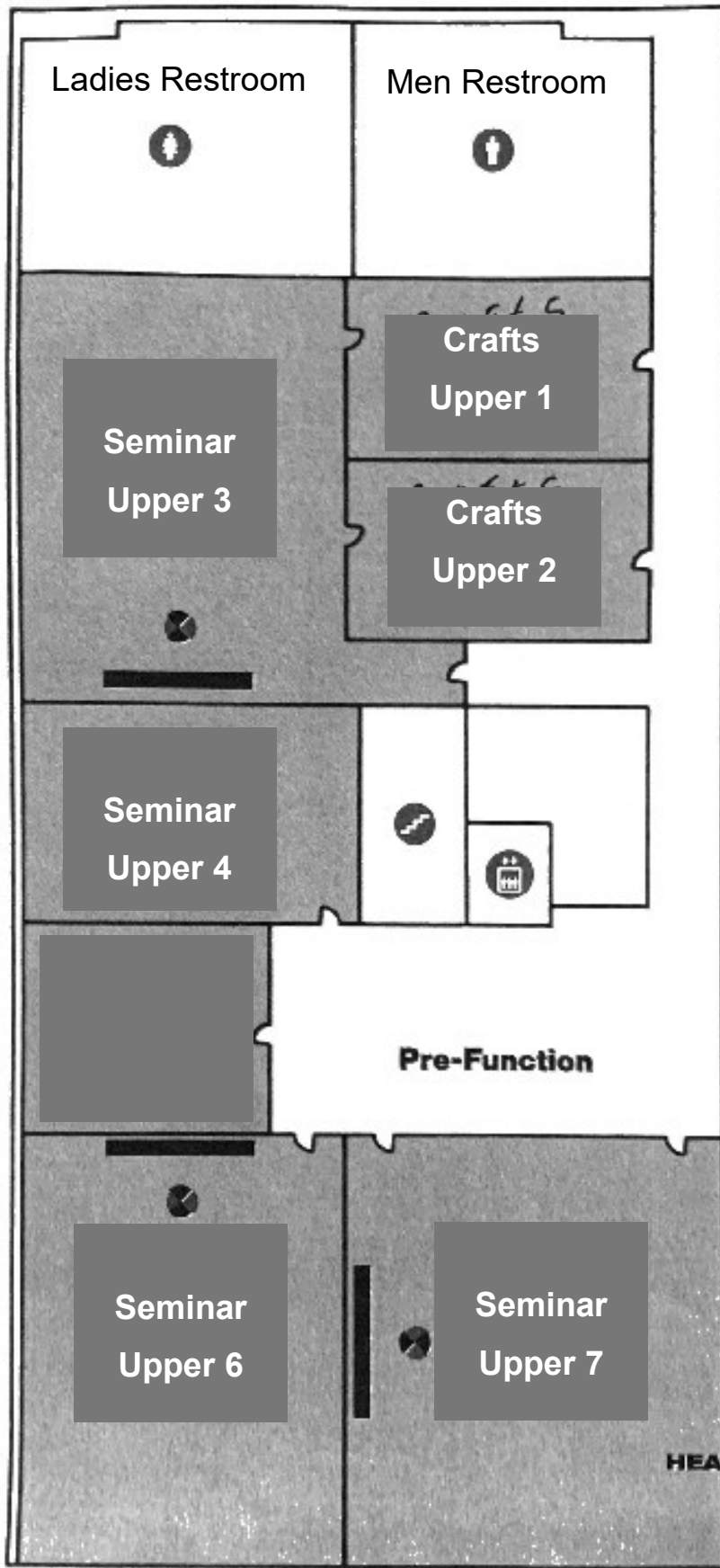

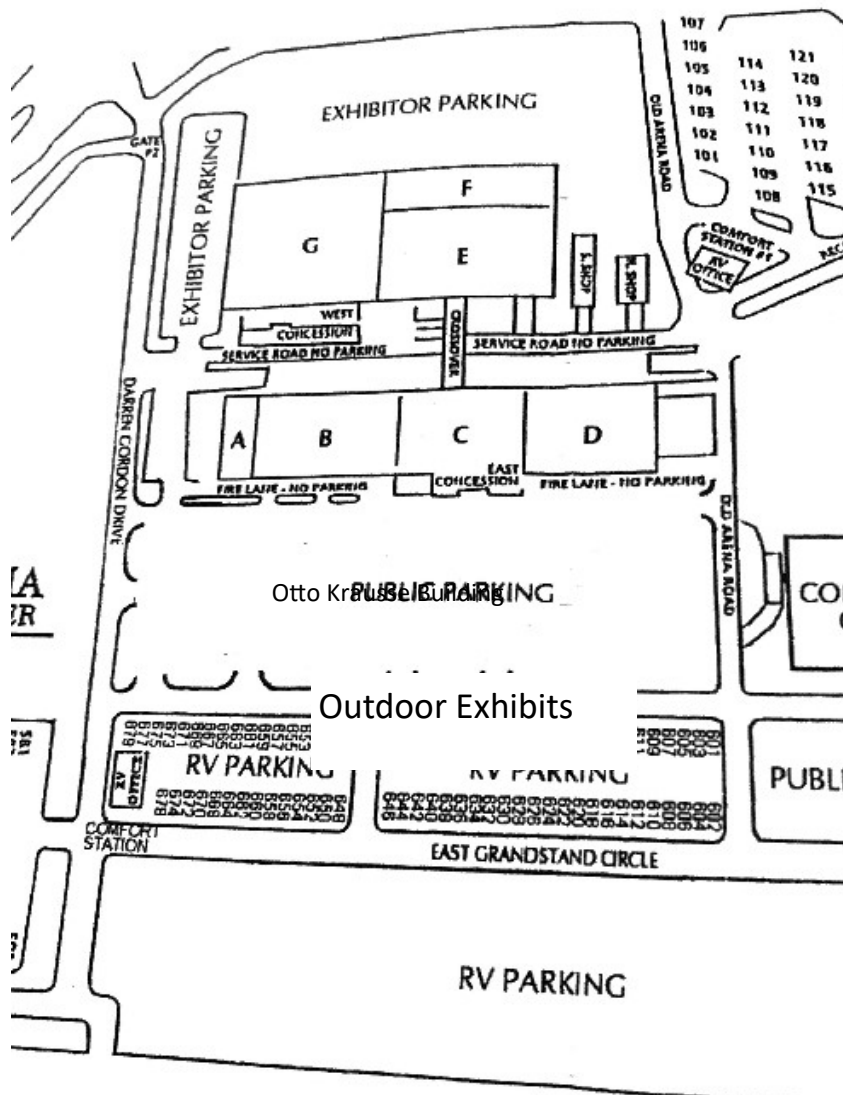

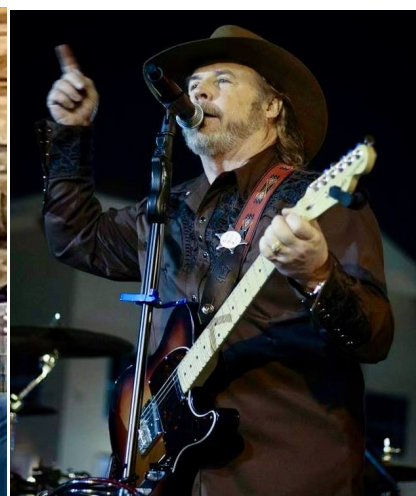
